18 Pursuant to Penal Code § 1269b(c), the judges of the above-  
19 entitled Court have conducted their annual review of the Inyo  
20 County Bail Schedule, and good cause appearing therefore, IT IS  
21 HEREBY ORDERED that the countywide Bail Schedule set forth  
22 herein is hereby adopted, and the same shall become fully  
23 effective and implemented at 12:01 a.m. on September 1, 2017.

24 This Order shall supersede all prior orders, and the bail  
25 schedule set forth herein shall supersede the current and all  
26 prior bail schedules adopted in Inyo County, including, but not  
27 necessarily limited to, this Court's "Order Adopting Bail  
28 Schedule," SISOAD 16-045, filed August 29, 2016.

1           The Court adopts and incorporates herein by reference the  
2 revised "Uniform Bail and Penalty Schedules 2017 Edition,"  
3 adopted by the Judicial Council of California (Cal. Rules of  
4 Court, rule 4.102), for Traffic, Boating, Forestry, Fish and  
5 Game, Public Utilities, Parks and Recreation, and Business  
6 Licensing; and, as may be amended, modified, or adopted by the  
7 Judicial Council in the future.

8           The purpose of this bail schedule is to fix an amount upon  
9 which a person who is arrested without a warrant may be released  
10 from custody prior to appearance in court. The bail schedule  
11 set forth herein below shall apply to any individual or  
12 defendant arrested without a warrant for a bailable misdemeanor  
13 or felony offense.

14           At and after a defendant's first appearance, pursuant to  
15 Penal Code § 1269b(b), the amount of bail, if any is allowed,  
16 shall lie with the sound discretion of the judicial officer  
17 before whom the defendant appeared, and may be greater or less  
18 than the amount set forth in this schedule, subject to the  
19 provisions of Penal Code § 1275.

20           This schedule may also be used by a magistrate in fixing  
21 bail pursuant to Penal Code § 815a at the time an arrest warrant  
22 is issued, the amount of which lies with the sound discretion of  
23 the magistrate.

24           When a defendant is booked for or charged with two or more  
25 offenses, bail shall be the amount computed under this schedule  
26 for the charge having the highest bail, except: (1) where the  
27 offenses are committed against separate victims or on separate  
28 dates, or (2) where separate sex acts are committed on the same

1 victim and each may be punished separately (including  
2 circumstances enumerated in Penal Code §§ 667.6(c) and (d)).  
3 Bail shall be calculated to include any applicable enhancements.  
4 Enhancements shall be added one time per person arrested, per  
5 defendant, or per case.

6 Penal Code § 1270.1 prohibits the release of an arrestee on  
7 bail in an amount other than that set forth in this Bail  
8 Schedule prior to a hearing in open court for: (a) Violent  
9 felonies as described in Penal Code § 667.5(c), but not 460(a);  
10 (b) Serious felonies as described in Penal Code § 1192.7(c)  
11 (including those listed in Penal Code § 1192.8); (c) Violations  
12 of Penal Code §§ 136.1(c), 243(e)(1), 262, 273.5, 422 (as a  
13 felony), and 646.9; and, (d) Violation of Penal Code § 273.6 if  
14 the detained person made threats to kill or harm, has engaged in  
15 violence against, or has gone to the residence or workplace of  
16 the protected party.

17 Except as expressly provided herein, bail for all  
18 MISDEMEANOR offenses, not included in the aforesaid Uniform Bail  
19 Schedule, shall be set at Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000). Bail  
20 shall be set as follows for the following specified misdemeanor  
21 offenses:

22 CVC § 23152(a) and/or (b) with two prior convictions [of  
23 CVC §§ 23152, 23153, 23103 as specified in § 23103.5; PC §§  
24 191.5 or 192(c)(3)] occurring within ten (10) years  
(offense date to offense date) \$25,000

25 PC § 166(a)(4) \$15,000  
26 When based upon an alleged violation of an "Emergency  
27 Protective Order" issued pursuant to Family Code §§  
6250 et seq.

28 PC § 166(c) \$10,000

Bail on FELONY offenses shall be set as follows:

Except as expressly provided herein, bail shall be set for felonies punishable by a maximum term up to and including 36 months in state prison, whether or not said offense is punishable under Penal Code § 1170(h) by a state prison commitment to be served in county jail, at Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000).

Exceptions:

- Bail shall be set in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for a felony violation of Health & Safety Code § 11378
- Bail shall be set in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for a felony violation of Vehicle Code § 2800.2(a).
- Bail shall be set in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for a felony violation of CVC § 23153.
- Bail shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for a felony violation of CVC § 23153 or CVC § 23152 with one or more prior felony convictions occurring within ten (10) years [offense date to offense date] of CVC §§ 23152 [punished under CVC § 23550, or under former § 23175 or former §

1 23175.5, or both]; CVC § 23153; PC § 192(c)(1); PC §  
2 191.5; or PC § 192(c)(3).

- 3 • Bail shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand  
4 Dollars (\$100,000) for a felony violation of CVC §  
5 23152 with three or more prior misdemeanor convictions  
6 of CVC §§ 23152, 23153, 23103 specified in § 23103.5,  
7 PC §§ 191.5 or 192(c)(3), occurring within ten (10)  
8 years [offense date to offense date].

- 9 • Bail shall be set in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars  
10 (\$50,000) for a felony violation of Penal Code §§  
11 4532(a) [Escape or attempted escape of misdemeanant  
12 from jail without force or violence], and 4532(e)  
13 [Failure of misdemeanant to return to jail subsequent  
14 to temporary release].

- 15 • Bail shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand  
16 Dollars (\$100,000) for a felony violation of Penal  
17 Code §§ 4532(b) [Escape or attempt of felon from jail  
18 without force or violence], and 4532(e) [Failure of  
19 felon to return to jail subsequent to temporary  
20 release].

21 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies  
22 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 36  
23 months, up to and including 48 months, bail shall be set at  
24 Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000).

25 Exception:

- 26 • Bail shall be set in the sum of Thirty Five Thousand  
27 Dollars (\$35,000) for a felony violation of Health &  
28 Safety Code § 11379(a).

29 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies  
30 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 48  
31 months, up to and including 60 months, bail shall be set in the  
32 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).

33 Exception: Bail for a felony violation of Vehicle Code §  
34 2800.3 shall be set in the sum of One Hundred Thousand  
35 Dollars (\$100,000).

1 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies  
2 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 60  
3 months, and up to and including 72 months, bail shall be set in  
4 the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

5 Except as expressly provided herein, for felonies  
6 punishable by a maximum term in state prison in excess of 72  
7 months, bail shall be set at Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand  
8 Dollars (\$250,000).

9 The following felonies shall have bail specifically set as  
10 follows:

- 11 • Stalking under any subdivision of PC § 646.9 in the  
12 sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).
- 13 • Attempted Murder shall be set at Five Hundred Thousand  
14 Dollars (\$500,000).
- 15 • Murder - PC § 187 in the sum of One Million Dollars  
16 (\$1,000,000).
- 17 • Capital Offenses - Unless deemed a nonbailable offense  
18 as provided by Penal Code § 1270.5 or Article I,  
19 Section 12 of the *California Constitution*, murder with  
20 one or more allegations of special circumstances, or  
21 any other offense punishable by death, in the sum of  
22 Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000).

23 Bail shall be set in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars  
24 (\$5,000) for an alleged VIOLATION OF MISDEMEANOR SUMMARY OR  
25 INFORMAL PROBATION (Conditional Revocable Release), which has  
26 been granted by the Superior Court of California, County of  
27 Inyo.

28 Bail shall be set for a VIOLATION OF MISDEMEANOR FORMAL  
PROBATION granted by the Superior Court of California, County of  
Inyo, in the amount of (\$10,000) Ten Thousand Dollars.

Bail shall be set for a VIOLATION OF FELONY FORMAL  
PROBATION, granted by the Superior Court of California, County  
of Inyo, in the amount set forth herein for the offense for


1 which the probationer was convicted and placed on said  
2 probation.


3 Said bail for a violation of misdemeanor or felony  
4 probation (whether formal or informal) granted by a Court of  
5 Inyo County, shall be in addition to any bail set for any new  
6 misdemeanor or felony arrest, if any.

7 Nothing herein shall preclude application for an increase  
8 in bail as provided by the provisions of PC § 1269c, or for a no  
9 bail hold as provided by PC § 1270.5 and/or Article I, Section  
10 12 of the *California Constitution*.

11 This Order and Bail Schedule shall remain in full force and  
12 effect, until modified by further Order of the Court.
